A confidential, temporary refuge where you can access support, advice and take time to determine your future.

Davis House for men & children



1 in 6 men will experience Domestic Abuse

Community Support

The community team provide confidential specialist Domestic Abuse support in all areas of Montgomeryshire.

Domestic violence regularly accounts for between 16-25% of all recorded violence in Powys



MFCC will support you through a specialist Domestic Abuse programme, guiding you on how to keep yourself and your children safe.

2014 - 2015 a total of 829 incidents of domestic violence were reported to the police in Powys, over half were from Montgomeryshire.

Safety Trust & Respect Club (S.T.A.R.)

S.T.A.R Club is a fun and relaxed, yet safe and confidential environment which provides children and young people with the opportunity to explore their feelings around domestic abuse.



75% of children on the child protection register live in a household where domestic abuse occurs
